- **Restaurant “Cal Borni”** (on the road to Fumanya). Speciality in mashed potatoes and grilled meat.
- **Bar “Bugui”.** Specialists in quality tapas.
- **Bar Cal Sastre:** it's the village Bar where everyone meets. ☎ 938 227 036
- **Grocery store. “La Botigueta”.** ☎ 938 227 071. Can make orders. Specialty in lamb meat and sausages.

LES VALLS DEL PEDRAFORCA

Vallcebre is the entrance to the Pedraforca valleys that reach La Vansa. I recommend you discover them.

Massanés: the privileged view of Pedraforca.

Saldes: at the foot of Pedraforca.

- Gresolet valley and Sanctuary of Gresolet. Picnic area with the possibility of firing.
- Pedraforca Parc Aventura: The adventure in the woods. ☎ 616 554 039.
- Climb to Encija. Go down the Canelassa and get off at Font Freda.

Gósol: beautiful town behind Pedraforca.

- Museu Picasso. With lithographs of the works he painted in the summer of 1906 in Gósol. ☎ 973 37 0055.
- Climb to the Castle. Views over the valley from the old village.
- Restaurant El Forn. Innovative cuisine with traditional air. ☎ 973 370 274
- Farm-Bar Cal Paraire. The specialty is omeletes with mushrooms. ☎ 973 370 014.
- Torrentsenta. Birth of the river Aigua de Valls. Picnic area with the possibility of firing.
- Rise to Pedraforca by Seven Sources, and get off by the hurdle.
- Excursion to Pont Quebradís by 4x4 or on foot.

Josa: a very picturesque village at the foot of the Sierra del Cadí. Take a walk through the village and get to the church.
